ATTIRE GUIDELINES

Thursday:

REGISTRATION + DINNER + OPENING CEREMONIES + OPENING ACTIVITY: *Casual*

Friday:

MEET THE CANDIDATES SESSION + WORKSHOPS: *Business Casual*

Guys: Jeans, khakis, polo style short sleeved shirts, button down shirts are acceptable.

Girls: Jeans, khakis, nice top/blouse, dress, appropriate length skirt, are acceptable.

- No shorts on guys or girls.
- No t-shirts.
- No holes in clothing.

DANCE-A-THON: *Casual*

Saturday:

BUSINESS SESSION + PHILANTHROPY SESSION: *Business Attire*

Guys: khakis or slacks, collared shirt (coat + tie recommended but not required)

Girls: pants suit, skirt suit, professional dress, etc.

- No denim.
- No shorts on guys or girls.
- No t-shirts.
- No holes in clothing.

FREE TIME: *Casual*

CLOSING BANQUET: *Formal*

Guys: suit + tie or slacks, coat + tie

Girls: pants or skirt suit, cocktail dress or long/formal gown

- No denim.
- No shorts on guys or girls.
- No t-shirts.
- No holes in clothing.

CLOSING ACTIVITY: *Casual*

Overall Guidelines:

- If shorts are worn at an appropriate time, they **MUST** be fingertip length (when arms are straight by sides).
- If holes in clothing are worn at an appropriate time, they **MUST** not be above fingertip length (when arms are straight by sides). If holes appear in tops, an undershirt **MUST** be worn if the hole(s) falls between shoulders and waistline.
- If dresses or skirts are worn, they **MUST NOT** be shorter than 5" above the knee (index card length).
- **NO BARE MIDRIFTS.** When arms are lifted above the head, no midriff should be shown.
- **NO LOW CUT TOPS OR DRESSES.** Be mindful of this when leaning over. Undershirts or camisoles should be worn when needed.
- If leggings are worn at an appropriate time, your top or dress **MUST** cover your bottom.

Anyone in violation of these guidelines will be asked by Civitan International, a chaperone, or member of the Sergeant-At-Arms committee to change.
