



39th Annual Junior Civitan International Convention
PARTICIPANT CODE OF CONDUCT

Civitan International and the Sergeant-at-Arms Committee hope every delegate and visitor will fully enjoy the convention. To ensure the comfort and pleasure of everyone, the following Code of Conduct has been established and each individual is expected to follow it.

1. All Junior Civitans are expected to conduct themselves as responsible young adults as you are representing Junior Civitan International at all times.
2. All Junior Civitans are REQUIRED to attend all sessions and events of the convention. Each Junior Civitan shall indicate his or her presence to the assigned chaperone upon arrival at each event. During designated free time, any Junior Civitan that leaves the hotel must be accompanied by a chaperone.
3. No alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, electronic cigarettes/vaping devices, or drugs of any kind (with the exception of prescribed medication) will be permitted in the possession of anyone attending the convention.
4. Junior Civitans are expected to be in their own rooms at each night's curfew, and they are expected to remain there. Unnecessary and excessive noises at any hour are prohibited. Curfews are set by Civitan International staff and will be clearly announced to all participants at the start of Convention.
5. Care shall be taken not to deface or destroy any property on the premises. Objects must not be thrown from windows. Smoking is not permitted. The unwarranted setting off of fire alarms or fire extinguishers is strictly prohibited. Damages will be paid for by the person(s) responsible.
6. Gambling, use of fireworks, the display of or distribution of obscene literature, in brief, any action unbecoming to a Junior Civitan will not be allowed.
7. Your attire throughout the weekend MUST follow the Attire Guidelines.
8. No female shall be allowed in the room of any male delegate, and no male may be in the room of any female delegate. The lobby of the hotel, pool area, and meeting space may be used for visiting. As a courtesy to other hotel guests, the hallways may NOT be used for visiting.
9. No Junior Civitan may change room assignments.
10. Name badges must be visibly worn at all times when delegates are within the hotel.
11. Any Junior Civitan driving a vehicle to the convention must give the vehicle keys to his or her chaperone upon arrival at the hotel.
12. Every member shall respect the authority of all chaperones and the Sergeant-at-Arms Committee.

Infractions of the Code of Conduct will be reported by the Sergeant-at-Arms Committee to the administration of Junior Civitan International. Appropriate action will be taken for any infractions, including the dismissal of any delegate or visitor from the convention at the expense of the individual, with a letter to his or her parent, school authorities, and Civitan authorities (i.e. Club advisor, District Chair, Sponsoring Club Liaison, etc.)
