

Junior Civitan International Fellows Program

What is a Junior Civitan International Fellow?

A Junior Fellow is any individual who contributes directly, or has contributed in his or her name, \$300 to the Civitan International Shropshire Scholarship Fund.

What is a Junior Civitan International Research Center Fellow?

A Junior Research Center Fellow is any individual who contributes directly, or has contributed in his or her name, \$600 to the Civitan International Research Center.

What happens then?

The honoree is presented a special plaque signifying that he or she is a Junior Fellow or Junior Research Center Fellow. The information is also published in Junior Civitan Insider and is announced at the international convention.

Suppose we wanted to make the Junior Fellow recognition a surprise?

That's no problem. If requested, the honoree will not be informed that a Fellow is being established in his or her name until an official announcement is made. The plaque can be presented at a club meeting, district convention or other appropriate occasion.

Suppose we collect more than \$300 or \$600. Will the extra money be returned to the contributors?

No. These are minimum contributions. We encourage additional contributions in the name of the Fellow. There is no limit to the amount that may be given. Should donations exceed the minimums and qualify your honoree for a higher level, you will be contacted.

Does a Junior Fellow have to be a Junior Civitan member or hold a particular club, district or international office?

No. Anyone may be honored as a Junior Fellow, it does not matter who the honoree is. The more money contributed, the more Civitans and Junior Civitans the funds can assist.

What can I do to help?

Encourage clubs to participate in the program. Consider honoring one individual each year at your district convention. Perhaps there are past or current Junior governors, district Junior chairpersons, a devoted parent or Junior international officer who may be considered for the honor. Is there a long time club advisor, Junior Civitan of the Year, outstanding club president, lieutenant governor or some other person you'd like to honor? It shouldn't be hard to think of a few deserving individuals. A Fellow-in-Memoriam is also an excellent tribute to that person's Civitan activities and a special gift for his or her family.
